## Have You Got a Team Ready for Ed Tech Day on August 16th?



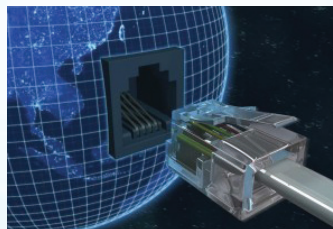
